#### Narrative

#### General Description/Forest Composition/History

The harvest area is located in the town of Rutland, north of Intervale Rd. It consists of 8.9 acres of a white pine/hardwood stand.

Tree species present in the overstory are white pine, red, black, and white oaks, red maple, pitch pine, black cherry, and eastern hemlock. The understory consists of eastern white pine, red and white oak, red maple, black birch, eastern hemlock and black cherry.

Glossy buckthorn is present but not well established. Some stems were hand pulled during tree marking.

The soils are moderately-well drained.

#### Site Selection

The primary goal of the watershed forest management program is to create and maintain a forest that provides high quality drinking water to current users and future generations. A healthy and resilient forest is comprised of diverse native tree and shrub species and multiple age classes of trees.

This harvest area was chosen because there is a high component of even aged low quality overstory white pine. Stands like these are low in diversity and susceptible to wind events.

#### Silvicultural Objectives

The harvest will remove the lower quality white pine in groups. The goal is to put enough sunlight on the ground to allow new natural regeneration of diverse species to be established. Five group selection openings of 0.8, 1.0, 1.7, 1.7, and 2.0 acres will be established, with a few healthy overstory trees retained in each opening. One 1.7 acre seed tree cut will also be established. Healthy overstory pitch pine and oaks will be retained in the seed tree cut.

#### **Cultural Resources**

Standard practice dictates that every effort is made to avoid disturbing stone walls and other cultural resources.

### **Rare or Endangered Species**

Natural Heritage Endangered Species Program (NHESP) does not show any rare habitat within the harvest area.




