2. Fold two opposite diagonal corners together, with the printed side up, then open back up.

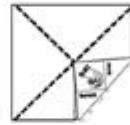
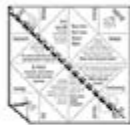
3. Fold the other two opposite corners together, then open back up.

4. You should have folded lines like this. The lines cross at the center of the paper.

5. Turn paper printed side down. Fold all four corners to the center of the paper.

6. When all four corners are folded, your future teller will look like this.

7. Flip your paper over so the text side with sun in the center is facing up.



8. Again, fold all four corners to the center of the paper.

9. When all four corners are folded, your future teller will look like this.

10. Fold any two sides together. Make sure the 4 pictures are on the outside.

11. Slide your fingers under the four flaps.

12. Finally, rotate your hands bringing your thumbs and index fingers together. The future teller should expand. Then open and play!
