

#### DCR Golf Course Program:

- Leo J. Martin Golf Course and Ski Area (18-hole golf course)
- Ponkapoag Golf Club (two 18-hole golf courses)

#### Interim COVID-19 Pandemic Operating Guidelines, updated June 1, 2020:

- Golf courses will be open to Massachusetts residents only as long as the quarantine is in effect.
- All Players will be required to book starting times. Walk-on players will not be allowed. Players may book starting times by calling the respective golf course at:
  - Ponkapoag: (781) 828-4242;
  - Leo J. Martin: (781) 894-4903.
- Daily fee players will be required to complete payment at exterior pay and display machines at each facility.
- Season pass holders may mail in their season pass application with a check.
- Starting times will be limited to 4 players or less.
- Starting time at Leo J. Martin will be spaced every 18 minutes e.g. 9:00 AM, 9:18 AM, etc.
- Starting times at Ponkapoag Course #1 and Course #2 will be spaced as follows:
  - If operating only Course #1 or #2-every 18 minutes;
  - If operating both Course # 1 and #2-every 36 minutes at each respective course, e.g. Course #1, 9:00 AM; Course #2, 9:18am; Course #1, 9:36am; Course #2, 9:54am, etc.
- Players must remain in their vehicles until 15 minutes before their starting time.
- No golf carts allowed, except as outlined here:
  - *The use of a motorized cart may be permitted for any individual with a disability who is seeking a reasonable accommodation to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). A golfer who wants to use a cart should provide documentation or otherwise certify in writing from a doctor to the golf course that he or she has a disability that requires the use of the cart.*
- Any golf carts used shall be cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- Pull carts will not be available for rent. Privately owned pull carts will be permitted.
- DCR will designate security personnel for both golf courses.
- All security personnel and grounds maintenance staff will be required to wear face coverings.
- The clubhouse, public bathrooms and concession areas will remain closed.
- Social distancing signage will be deployed at various locations at both golf courses.
- Driving ranges and practice putting greens will remain closed.
- Players will not be allowed to share golf clubs. Every player must carry or pull their own bag
- Players shall not touch the flagstick. Flagsticks must remain in hole. Hole liners will be raised so picking a ball out of the cup does not occur.
- Bunker rakes, ball washers and all other course amenities will be removed from both golf courses.

- Portable hand sanitizer stations will be deployed at both golf courses.
- Social distancing signage will be installed at both golf courses. Security personnel will enforce social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- Once your round is complete, you must leave the facility. There is no congregating at the completion of your round, this includes the parking lot.
