DCR Recreational Advisory: Boston Agency-Managed Ice Rinks Open for the Season on Black Friday

WHAT: On Friday, November 29, 2024, the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will open all agency-managed ice rinks in the City of Boston for public skating, except the Kelly Outdoor Rink in Jamaica Plain which will open for public skating between mid-December and mid-March, weather permitting. The skating season will run through April 13, 2025. Several agency-managed rinks opened for group rentals earlier this fall. The Steriti Rink will be closed from Monday, March 17, 2025, through Monday, March 31, 2025, to facilitate a special use permit.
