DCR Recreational Advisory: Cochituate State Park Boat Ramp and Parking Lot in Natick

WHAT: Beginning September 7, 2021 and continuing until June 10, 2022 the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will implement a closure of the Cochituate State Park boat ramp and its adjoining parking lot in the Town of Natick to accommodate a \$2.5 million renovation project. The renovation project will include a new boat ramp, new observation deck, and repaving and striping of the parking lot. Alternative boat ramps can be found at Ashland State Park in the Town of Ashland and Hopkinton State Park in the Town of Hopkinton.
