DCR Recreational Advisory: Cyanobacteria Bloom at Flax Pond in Nickerson State Park

WHAT: The Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) is warning the

public of a cyanobacteria bloom present in Flax Pond at Nickerson State Park in the Town of Brewster. During a bloom it is strongly advised that the public should not have contact with the water. Additionally, pet owners should keep their animals away from the shoreline to prevent them from ingesting the water.
