DCR Recreational Advisory: Cyanobacteria Bloom in Chicopee Reservoir

WHAT: The Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) is warning the

public of a cyanobacteria bloom present in Chicopee Reservoir at

Chicopee State Park in the City of Chicopee. During a bloom it is strongly

advised that the public should not have contact with the water. Additionally, pet owners should keep their animals away from the

shoreline to prevent them from ingesting the water. The waterbody will be
