DCR Recreational Advisory: Cyanobacteria Bloom in Lake Cochituate

WHAT: The Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) is warning the public of a cyanobacteria bloom present in the South Pond portion of Lake Cochituate in the Town of Natick. During a bloom it is strongly advised that the public should not have contact with the water. Additionally, pet owners should keep their animals away from the shoreline to prevent them from ingesting the water. The waterbody will be retested until cyanobacteria levels are within acceptable limits per Department of Public Health (DPH) guidelines.
