**DCR Recreational Advisory: Jamaica Plain Skatepark in Southwest
Corridor Park in the City of Boston**

WHAT: Effective immediately and continuing through Friday, September 17, 2021, the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will implement a closure of the Jamaica Plain Skatepark in the Southwest Corridor Park between Oakdale Street and Amory Street in the City of Boston and the adjacent pedestrian pathway to accommodate skatepark reconstruction work. Pedestrian pathways will be clearly marked. Alternative skateparks in proximity to Jamaica Plain Skatepark include the skatepark at Little Scobie Playground on Copeland Street in Boston and the Lynch Family Skatepark on Education Street in the City of Cambridge.
