DCR Recreational Advisory: Mount Greylock State Reservation

WHAT: Effective immediately, hikers will not be able to refill water bottles at the summit of Mount Greylock in the Town of Adams due to water quality issues with the potable water tap. Potable water is available to visitors at the Mount Greylock State Reservation campground and visitor center, and bottled water is available for sale at Bascom Lodge at the summit of Mount Greylock. Hikers are advised to bring extra water for their hikes up and down the mountain, and to fill their water bottles at the visitors center if necessary. Important to note, Bascom Lodge will close for the season on Sunday, October 23, 2022. Additionally, the road to the summit will close, and amenities and other services at the summit will conclude at the end of the season on Sunday, October 30, 2022; however, the visitor's center remains open year round.
