## **UPDATE: DCR Traffic Advisory: Lynn Fells Parkway in Melrose**

WHAT:

On Monday, April 28, 2025, and continuing through Monday, March 9, 2026 (excluding weekends), the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will begin construction on an intersection improvement project of Lynn Fells Parkway and Melrose Street in the City of Melrose from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The work includes curb layout, ADA ramps, and adding traffic signals to the intersection.

DCR will implement a lane shift for much of the construction period. Traffic will be maintained in both directions with occasional interruptions as needed. DCR will issue additional traffic advisories if significant interruptions are expected. Traffic patterns will be clearly marked, and a police detail will be coordinated as necessary.
