DCR Traffic Advisory: Revere Beach Boulevard in Revere

WHAT: On Wednesday, January 10, 2018, through Saturday, January 13, 2018, the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will close Revere Beach Boulevard in the City of Revere to accommodate film production work. Revere Beach Boulevard will be closed between Eliot Circle and Revere Street from 7:00AM to 12:00PM; additionally, the roadway will be closed between Shirley Street and Revere Street from 12:00PM to 5:00PM. Traffic patterns will be clearly marked and a police detail will be on site.
