DCR Traffic and Parking Advisory: Head of the Charles Regatta

WHAT:

From Wednesday, October 15, 2025, through Sunday, October 19, 2025, the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will close various roadways and implement traffic and parking restrictions in the Cities of Boston and Cambridge to accommodate the Head of the Charles Regatta. Road Closures:

- **Eliot Bridge:** Outbound lanes only, closed from Boston to Cambridge on Saturday, October 18, and Sunday, October 19 from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Parking Restrictions:

- **Greenough Boulevard:** No parking.
- Soldiers Field Road, Lots 1-4: Closed Wednesday, October 15, at 10 p.m. to Sunday, October 19, at 8 p.m.
