DCR Winter Storm Advisory: Various State-Managed Roadways

What: The Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) may implement parking bans for agency-managed roadways and designated Department of Transportation (DOT) managed roadways due to the pending winter storm event. The timing of parking bans on DCR and DOT roadways will be consistent with local municipal bans; **please refer to local parking ban announcements. All parking bans on these roadways will apply to both sides of the road. Cars parked in these areas during an active snow ban may be ticketed and towed.** Parking bans are expected to be lifted shortly after the completion of snow clearing operations. McGrath Hwy (Somerville)

Where: Both sides of DCR roadways, and above-listed DOT-managed roadways, in municipalities with parking bans in effect – **please refer to local parking ban announcements.**

When: The timing of DCR parking bans will be in accordance with local municipal parking bans in which these roads are located – **please refer to local parking ban announcements.**
