**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and other local workforce partners that MOSES 40.8 is scheduled for release to the desktops on Wednesday, May 29, 2024.

**Background:** MOSES will be shut down at 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 28, 2024, for the updates and the maintenance of the MOSES software and MOSES Applications (JobQuest / TrainingPro).

This will **NOT** interrupt other IT services or functions to the offices, only MOSES will be taken off-line. Email, unemployment assistance systems and internet services will still be available.

Please plan on completing and saving your MOSES data entry by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 28, 2024, and then log off MOSES. This will ensure that when you log into MOSES on your next workday, you will have the new version of MOSES available, and any work done prior will be saved.

The MOSES build is planned to be released Wednesday, May 29, 2024, to desktops.

**Action**

**Required:** MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and workforce partners should ensure that their staff are aware of the MOSES shutdown on Tuesday, May 28, 2024, and that Career Centers and other MOSES users plan their workloads accordingly in preparation for MOSES to shut down at 4:30 p.m.

### 1. Staff View - Change Migrant Seasonal Farm Worker fields on Basic and Full tab:

- Removed: *Migrant Food Processor*
- Add hover to *Seasonal Farmworker*: Select if the customer does not live in housing provided by their employer
- Add hover to *Migrant Farmworker*: Select if the customer lives in housing provided by their employer
- Remove pop-up alerts on Full tab when the radio buttons are clicked
