Subject: MOSES Version 41.0 will be released on Wednesday, January 22, 2025

Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and

other local workforce partners that MOSES 41.0 is scheduled for release to the

desktops on Wednesday, January 22, 2025.

Background: MOSES and MOSES applications (JobQuest and TrainingPro) will be shut down at

4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, for the updates and the maintenance of

the MOSES software and MOSES Applications (JobQuest / TrainingPro).

This will **NOT** interrupt other IT services or functions to the offices, only MOSES and MOSES applications (JobQuest and TrainingPro) will be taken off-line. Email, unemployment assistance systems and internet services will still be available.

Please plan on completing and saving your MOSES data entry by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, and then log off MOSES. This will ensure that when

you log into MOSES on your next workday, you will have the new version of MOSES available, and any work done prior will be saved.

The MOSES build is planned to be released Wednesday, January 22, 2025, to desktops.

partners should ensure that their staff are aware of the MOSES shutdown on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, and that Career Centers and other MOSES users plan their workloads accordingly in preparation for MOSES to shut down at 4:00 p.m.

Description of Key Changes in MOSES 41.0

1. The length of the displayed Program Name in the Employer record > Programs and Benefits tab will be increasing in width to allow users to see more of the program name.



2. The Pay Details field in a Job Order record > Pay Specification tab is increasing from 255 characters to 1000 characters.



3. The "Change MJQ Username/Email" and "Change MJQ Password" functions will be removed from the Administration drop-down menu to facilitate the change for job seekers accounts to MyMassGov (see Information issuance **100 DCS 02.164** for more details).
