Purpose:	To notify Local Workforce Development Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce partners that FEMA and the government of Puerto Rico recently announced Transitional Sheltering Assistance (TSA) is available to Puerto Ricans who are unable to return to their homes because they are displaced as a result of Hurricanes Irma and Maria. This is one of several short-term housing options offered to meet the demand for post-storm safe housing.
Background:	Transitional Sheltering Assistance allows eligible applicants to shelter in a hotel or motel, for a limited period of time, as a bridge to immediate and longer-term housing.
