| Background: | MassMATCH is the Commonwealth of Massachusetts initiative to maximize assistive technology in consumer's hands. MassMATCH promotes the use of   |

assistive technology in consumer's hands. MassMATCH promotes the use of assistive technology services to enhance the independence of people with disabilities, enabling equal participation in all of life's activities. MassMATCH is one of 56 federally-funded statewide assistive technology initiatives in the United States.

MassMATCH is funded by the Administration for Community Living of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, and managed by the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission.

A variety of assistive technology resources are available through MassMATCH to assist individuals with disabilities, family members, and disability-related providers, agencies, and organizations across the state.

- Massachusetts Assistive Technology Loan Program
- Massachusetts Long-Term Device Loan Program
- REquipment Durable Medical Equipment Reuse Program

MassMATCH has three Assistive Technology Regional Centers (ATRCs) that provide demonstrations of the latest assistive technology equipment to the general public. Individuals with disabilities, family members, educators, employers, therapists and others learn more about assistive technology through these hand-on opportunities. The ATRCs also loan out assistive technology equipment for use.
