Subject:	Urgent Action Required: Local Area Single Point of Contact Designation Needed

Purpose:To request that MassHire Workforce Areas to assign a Single Point of Contact
(SPoC), as well as a backup, for the Humanitarian Food Service Employment
component of the COVID-19 Disaster Dislocated Worker Grant Project.

Background: The Department of Labor (DOL) awarded Massachusetts/MassHire Department of Career Services (MDCS) \$6.9 million in disaster relief funding to address the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. A majority of the funds will be used for food service relief. Food preparation and delivery is critical in support of the Commonwealth's elderly and other populations. With grant funds, displaced food service workers will be temporarily re-employed in support of larger food preparation and distribution efforts. While the employer of record will be Snapchef, MassHire Career Centers will be instrumental in recruiting and identifying eligible grant participants to fill these critical positions. To best coordinate the process, we ask that each MassHire Workforce Area designate 1 staff member to be the SPoC and 1 backup to work closely with Snapchef regional staff. A **webinar** outlining the project, requirements and process will be offered **Thursday, June 11**th, via WebEx (details to follow), to familiarize individuals with the operations of this grant. A policy with pertinent guidance, forms and templates is forthcoming.
