**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and other workforce partners of the Department of Labor (DOL), Employment and Training Administration (ETA), Training and Employment Notice (TEN) No. 08-22: Building Pathways to Infrastructure Careers – Framework for Preparing an Infrastructure Workforce, released October 21, 2022.
