Subject:	Supplemental Employment Data Tracking / Reporting Webinar	
Purpose:	To notify Local Workforce Development Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce partners of a webinar scheduled for Thursday, December 7 at 10:00am, to discuss the tracking and reporting of supplemental employment data for federal reporting.	
Background:	The USDOL/ETA TEGL 26-16 and MassWorkforce Issuance 100 DCS 09.110 both discuss the use of supplemental employment data (i.e. data collected after exit through participant follow up service) for WIOA performance measurements. Employment data collected through the follow up process will only be used in federal performance measurement in the case where a UI wage match cannot be found for an individual, such as for self employed individuals, individuals employed by the federal government, and individuals where no SSN was obtained.	
	While supplemental employment data may still be used in WIOA performance measurement, there is a significant change to the process, and all staff involved with follow up services should be aware of this change. WIOA requires that in the case where a UI wage match is not found, only a <i>verified total quarterly wage amount</i> be collected and used for the federal report to indicate employment. These collected wage amounts will be closely scrutinized as part of the data validation process. The webinar will discuss the rules for using these wages in
