Using learning modules based on competencies can help learners get to credential attainment faster and with less expense. The Trade Adjustment Assistance Community College and Career Training (TAACCCT) program funded the creation and enhancement of Competency-Based Education programs, which

measure student achievement based on mastery of competencies as demonstrated through performance-based assessments. Hear two TAACCCT grantees present resources they developed and strategies that they found effective for enacting CBE programming.
