Subject: **Apprenticeship 101 Webinar**

Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and other workforce partners about an Apprenticeship learning opportunity.

Background: Registered Apprenticeship (RA) is a training and employment model that produces highly skilled workers to meet the demands of employers competing in a global economy. RA ensures authentic, applied learning by combining on-the-job learning with theoretical and practical classroom instruction to prepare exceptional workers.

MassHire DCS is hosting “Apprenticeship 101” for practitioners with limited knowledge or experience with the model.
