- **Background:** Since 2015, the RESEA program has provided Unemployment Insurance (U.I.) customers with a full array of re-employment services at MassHire Career Centers and has helped to ensure that customers comply with all their U.I. eligibility requirements. RESEA customers are active job seekers with U.I. claims who, through the state's RESEA program, are made aware of the wide variety of re-employment services that are available to them. All RESEA customers are provided with U.I. eligibility assessments, individual re-employment plans, and referrals to appropriate re-employment services based on their individual needs.
