Purpose:	To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and other workforce partners that the MIC program was officially launched by the Governor's

- workforce partners that the MIC program was officially launched by the Governor's office on January 5th and MDCS has added an additional training as follow-up to the announcement. The training is scheduled for Thursday, January 21st.
- **Background:** Mass Internet Connect (MIC) is a Partnership comprising Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (MTC), MassHire Department of Career Services (MDCS) and the MassHire Workforce Development System working together to connect job seekers with the tools, services and internet connections necessary to "get people back to work".

The MIC program is a state-wide initiative that is supported by the Governor's office. The goal of partnering with MTC is to assist Massachusetts' <u>unemployed</u> job seekers who are looking for work to gain internet access and become aware of this program through the state's network of MassHire Career Centers. The scheduled virtual training date is: Thursday, January 21st at 1:00pm - 2:30pm
