Subject: **Executive Office of Elder Affairs (EOEA) notice of Personal and Home Care Aide State Training (PHCAST) Online**

Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and other workforce development partners that the Executive Office of Elder Affairs (EOEA) is now offering Personal and Home Care Aid State Training (PHCAST) online. This free, virtual, and self-paced training is for anyone interested in becoming a community-based home care worker.

Background: Home care aides are an integral part of the in-home care team. They provide services that support older adults and persons with disabilities to live and thrive in their homes and communities, as well as to make decisions about their care and lifestyle.

PHCAST is a self-paced, video-based, 11-module online training. Each module can be completed from a home computer or smartphone. Training enrollees learn about the roles and responsibilities of a home care aide, including skills like active listening, nutrition planning, housekeeping, and working with consumers.
