PCAs support consumer-employers with activities of daily living that allow them to live in their own homes and remain active in their community. PCA Facts There are flexible "mother's hours" positions available. • There are part-time, evening, weekend, and overnight shifts available. • • The application process is free and easy. PCAs can be hired at age 14 (some restrictions apply to PCAs under age 18). • Job seekers can start right away, they get all their training on-the-job.
