Subject: Connecting to the Public Workforce System – An Introduction for Youth Service

Providers - WorkforceGPS Webinar

Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and

other workforce partners of an upcoming WorkforceGPS webinar – <u>Connecting</u> to the Public Workforce System – An Introduction for Youth Service Providers,

April 20, 2022 from 12:00 – 1:00.

Background: This webinar is intended for organizations that are unfamiliar with the public

workforce system. It will provide a high-level, introductory overview of the public workforce system, highlight how youth and young adult service providers typically connect, and preview common opportunities within the Department of

Labor.

Organizations that provide workforce development and career pathways

services to youth and young adults are vital contributors to the workforce system but may not be deeply connected to the existing public system infrastructure. This webinar is an introductory overview of the public workforce system and the most common points of entry for youth and young adult-serving entities, designed for groups that are unfamiliar with the system. It is the first in a series of conversations that will more deeply illuminate specific points of entry, common requirements and processes, and useful resources for becoming successful members of the public workforce system. Attendees of this session will learn the most common points of entry into the public workforce system for youth-serving organizations, be made aware of existing DOL funding opportunities, and get a preview of opportunities for deeper learning over the coming months.

WorkforceGPS is an online technical assistance website created to help build the capacity of America's public workforce investment system. Sponsored by the Employment and Training Administration of the U.S. Department of Labor, WorkforceGPS was developed specifically for workforce professionals, educators, and business leaders. WorkforceGPS is free but does require account registration.
