**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and other workforce partners of an upcoming WorkforceGPS webinar – [Providing Access to Voting Through the American Job Center Network Overview](#), April 20, 2022 from 3:30 – 4:30.

**Background:** The U.S. Department of Labor will provide a discussion of its new guidance, [Training and Employment Guidance Letter 08-21](#), Providing Access to Voting through the American Job Center (AJC) Network. The webinar provides details about how an AJC can become a voter registration agency; describes how the workforce system can support local boards and operators interested in becoming a voter registration agency; and reporting expectations for the workforce system.

WorkforceGPS is an online technical assistance website created to help build the capacity of America's public workforce investment system. Sponsored by the Employment and Training Administration of the U.S. Department of Labor, WorkforceGPS was developed specifically for workforce professionals, educators, and business leaders. WorkforceGPS is free but does require account registration.
