- **Background:** The MassHire Department of Career Services (MDCS) will be offering training sessions for MassHire Career Center staff and partners to assist customers and/or businesses in their re-employment and/or hiring efforts from September December 2022.

## The following NEW training will be offered in addition to MDCS training offerings:

1. EOLWD's Department of Economic Research (DER) will conduct **Occupational Employment and Wages Statistics (OEWS) Program** training on September 20, 2022. It will cover how data is collected, where it is published, and how to interpret the data. This webinar will acquaint staff with one of DER's data product offerings.  In October, MDCS and the Massachusetts Workforce Association (MWA) are cosponsoring a workshop series offered by Advocates for Human Potential/Access to Recovery (AHP/ATR) called Fundamentals of Substance Use Disorders and Recovery. Training will consist of four (4) individual 1-hour sessions, each focused on a specific area of critical importance in the field of recovery.
