**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and other local workforce partners of the availability of an online training through the State Ethics Commission regarding the Conflict-of-Interest Training. After self-registering to access the new conflict of interest law online program on the Commission's learning platform, Individuals can complete the training on a computer or mobile device. The new program has relevant content specific to public positions and is available in four languages.

**Background:** The new program provides tools to help those tasked with keeping track of employee compliance with the conflict-of-interest law education requirements more efficiently.
