 - Examples of the kind of impact collaborating with mandatory partners can have on improving performance measure outcomes.
- Setting Leading Indicators for WIOA Performance Measures
 - Reviewing which leading indicators can be used to help staff move toward meeting overall performance measures.
 - Examples of boards that have used leading indicators and how they determine which ones will help them meet performance measures.

Attendees will come away with:

- Strategies on how to work collaboratively on WIOA common performance measures with mandatory partners.
- Strategies and overall engagement approaches of how best to incorporate the six WIOA measures into local plans and programming.

- A more complete understanding of which other measures to include in their local areas, to ensure a more comprehensive and overall inclusive workforce services delivery model.
- Building partnership and collaboration between the Workforce Development Boards (WDB) & their mandated partners – and how it relates to identifying and reporting on any additional measures that could be beneficial to the local areas.
