Background:	Join three regional Workforce Development Boards (WDBs) from across the Nation - representing various sizes and contexts – as they share their first-hand experiences and strategies for meeting WIOA compliance while advancing strategic objectives. These experts will discuss diverse approaches to planning, community engagement, and certifying American Job Centers (AJCs), with a particular focus on improving customer service and fostering collaboration. Attendees will gain practical insights into how peers within the workforce system are refining planning and certification tactics to go "beyond compliance." The panelists will share the processes they used, the outcomes they achieved, and examples from their regions. Key Topics:

	 Maximizing Impact: Making the planning process meaningful to local ecosystems. Driving Innovation: Exploring styles that create synergy, improve performance, and enhance services. Overcoming Barriers: Understanding how AJC certification can help identify and tackle collaboration challenges. Adaptive Approaches: Reviewing different state strategies for certifications and planning. Streamlining Processes: Leveraging WIOA processes and certifications to maximize value and effectively utilize resources. The webinar will conclude with a Q&A session, allowing attendees to ask questions and address their specific needs.
