Subject: **Estimated Fiscal Year 2023 WIOA Title I Allotments**

Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and other workforce development partners of estimated Program Year 2022 / Fiscal Year 2023 Title I program allotments to guide future planning.

Background: The US Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration (ETA) issued Training and Employment Notice 20-21, *Planning Estimate for Workforce innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Program Allotments for Program Year (PY) 2022*, on February 2, 2022. ETA issued the estimated allotments for planning purposes. ETA based the projected statewide levels on the current fiscal year funding and data used for developing program allotments for PY 2022/FY 2023.

The MassHire Department of Career Services has developed the attached state and local estimates based on the estimated allotments from ETA. These estimates indicate increases in funding for WIOA Title I programs from current fiscal year levels. These estimates are for planning purposes only.
