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**Purpose:** To notify Local Workforce Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other

local workforce partners of a funding opportunity, *Apprenticeship Expansion Continuation Funds*, through the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL or the

Department) Employment and Training Administration (ETA).

Background: In November 2016, Massachusetts EOLWD/DCS, in partnership with

Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS), was awarded \$1.5 M by DOL/ETA for the purpose of expanding the number of registered apprenticeship (RA) programs in construction and trade and in new industries and expanding participation in RA from underrepresented opportunities. Massachusetts, and other states awarded Apprenticeship Expansion Grants are now invited to apply

for continuation funding.

**Application Deadline:** April 23, 2018 **Potential Funding:** \$1,816,649

**Period of Performance:** Award would extend the POP on the

current grant to Fall 2020.

DOL's vision for the funds is for recipients to build on the work done with funds from the initial round of funding by:

- > Developing an enduring, sustainable apprenticeship system within the US;
- Supporting well-paying, middle- & high-skilled, and high-growth jobs across a range of industries;

- ➤ Implementing quality program design and support retention and completion for apprentices; and
- > Developing and expanding regional workforce partnerships.

Massachusetts EOLWD/DCS will submit an application for this continuation Apprenticeship Expansion Grant funding opportunity. To build a strong application we are requesting ideas from state partners and the local workforce development system on how to best expand Registered Apprenticeship across the state and build up on the work done so far with funds from previous DOL funded apprenticeship grants.
