Subject: Apprenticeship Expansion - Related Technical Instruction (RTI) Grant RFR

To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and other workforce partners of an Apprenticeship Expansion Related Technical Instruction (RTI) grant RFR available through CommBuys Operational Services

Division.

Background: In June 2018, the Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development

(EOLWD) published the <u>Apprenticeship Expansion Plan</u>, a strategic planning document compiled with inputs from and the support of multiple education, business, labor, legislative, and community partners. The goals of the strategic

plan are to expand Registered Apprenticeship to priority industries of **healthcare, manufacturing, and technology**; and **diversify** the existing apprenticeship workforce. The statewide priority industries described above were developed through the Workforce Skills Cabinet's <u>Regional Planning</u>

Process.

To support the goals of the Apprentice Expansion Plan, Governor Baker and the Massachusetts Legislature approved a first-time state line item, 7003-0151. Related Technical Instruction (RTI) grants will be issued in accordance with this line item and the Apprenticeship Expansion Plan.

The grant funding will be used to pay for the cost of related technical instruction, or classroom instruction, for the addition of new apprentices to approved
Registered Apprenticeship programs in order to grow the total number of apprentices in the healthcare, manufacturing, and technology and diversify the existing apprenticeship workforce.
