Purpose: The MassHire Department of Career Services is seeking input from local areas

with regard to the *Notice of Availability of Funds and Funding Opportunity Announcement for ReEntry Projects (RP-3)* as described in the Department of Labor (DOL) Employment and Training Administration (ETA) Training and

Employment announcement released March 26, 2019.

Background: Through this funding opportunity, DOL/ETA seeks to enhance both adult and

young adult reentry strategies through collaboration with the field to identify and respond to emerging or chronic reentry challenges. This initiative intends to

assist communities in planning and implementing comprehensive reentry programs to help adults and young adults who have been involved in the juvenile

or adult justice system make successful transitions back to the community.

Applicants may submit up to 2 applications in response to this FOA, including a

maximum of 1 to serve adults and 1 to serve young adults.
