### 2. Project Design (FOA page 23)

- **a.** Evidence-Based and evidence-informed interventions or promising practices (must be one of the following)
  - i. Evidence-based and evidence-informed interventions
  - ii. New interventions that theory or research suggests are promising or
  - iii. A combination of these practices
- **b.** Partnerships and related services (All applicants must partner with the justice system)
  - i. Identify partners within justice system (correctional facilities, parole, probation...)
  - ii. Employers
- **c.** Past performance (see page 27 for specifics)
