Subject: TRAIN Grant Program FY20

**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and

other workforce development partners of a request for proposals announced for the FY20 Training Resources and Internships Networks (TRAIN) Grant Program.

**Background:** The legislature has once again funded the Department of Higher Education (DHE)

TRAIN grant program in the FY20 budget. Grant funds shall be awarded competitively to Massachusetts' community colleges. The total funding available

to be awarded through this competitive grant program is \$1,500,000. The DHE anticipates awarding up to 15 individual or collaborative grants in the range of \$75,000 to \$150,000 reflecting the program design, number of people served,

and planned outcomes.

Campuses and partnering community-based organizations are invited and encouraged to review the FY20 TRAIN program proposal guidelines. The Request
