Subject: H-1B Rural Healthcare Grant Program Funding Opportunity

Purpose:

To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and other local workforce partners that the Department of Labor (DOL) Employment and Training Administration (ETA) has announced the H-1B Rural Healthcare Grant Program, FOA-ETA-20-12, and approximately \$40 million in grant funds. Funds are authorized under the American Competitiveness and Workforce Improvement Act of 1998 (ACWIA), as amended (codified at 29 USC 3224a) for the H-1B Rural Healthcare Grant Program. The intent of this grant program is to alleviate healthcare workforce shortages by creating sustainable employment and training programs in healthcare occupations (including behavioral and mental healthcare) serving rural populations

Background: The recent COVID-19 crisis has placed an unprecedented strain on our nation's healthcare system. Rural areas have struggled with providing needed healthcare services to their communities. The purpose of the grant program is to:

> (1) increase the number of individuals training in healthcare occupations that directly impact patient care; and

(2) alleviate healthcare workforce shortages by creating sustainable employment and training programs in healthcare occupations (including behavioral and mental healthcare) serving rural populations.
