**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and other

local workforce partners of a funding opportunity through the Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, announced December 14 on Grants.gov, to award approximately \$3,555,619 for an estimated six to eight NFJP Career Services and Training grants in Connecticut, Rhode Island, Hawaii, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Maine, and key counties in the Central Coast, South Coast, and desert agricultural

regions of California.

Background: Under this Funding Opportunity Announcement, DOL will award Career Services and

Training grants through a competitive process to organizations providing career services, training services, youth services, related assistance services, and housing assistance to eligible migrant and seasonal farmworkers and their dependents.
