Subject: **Career Technical Initiative**

Purpose:

To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and other local workforce development partners of the Career Technical Initiative (CTI), a signature initiative of the Commonwealths' Workforce Skills Cabinet and Governor Baker.

Background: The FY21 State Budget included \$4 million for Workforce Skills Cabinet approved grants to fund 28 new career pathway programs at 10 vocational technical schools providing training and job placement to more than 428 adults to-date.

> The FY22 State Budget includes an expansion of investment to \$15.37 million (EOLWD Line Item 7002-1091) to scale 3rd shift adult retraining programs to 12-16 additional vocational schools projected to train 2,400 - 3,200 participants

> CTI is a signature initiative of the Workforce Skills Cabinet and Governor Baker:

Addresses persistent skills gap that employers face in construction/trades and manufacturing

- Provides opportunity for youth and adults to retrain for skilled occupations especially those hardest hit by COVID
- Transforms vocational high schools into Career Technical Institutes, running three shifts per day to expand enrollment of high school students and adults
- CTI is projected to train 20,000 new skilled workers in key trades and technical jobs as a multi-year strategy
