**Subject:** **Funding Opportunity – Homeless Veterans’ Reintegration Program (HVRP), Incarcerated Veterans’ Transition Program (IVTP), and the Homeless Female Veterans’ and Veterans’ with Children Program (HFVWC) (referred to collectively as HVRP)**

---

**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and other local workforce partners of a funding opportunity through the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL), Veterans’ Employment and Training Service (VETS), announcing the availability of approximately \$14,000,000 in grant funds authorized under Title 38 United States Code (U.S.C.) Sections 2021, 2021A, and 2023 for the HVRP.

**Background:** The HVRP grant has a three-year period of performance and is funded incrementally on an annual basis. Under this Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA), applicants may apply for a ceiling amount of up to \$500,000 for each year. This means that recipients may be funded up to a total of \$1,500,000 over the three-year period of performance.

Successful applicants must demonstrate clear strategies to provide needed career exploration and placement services, career training, and support services to eligible individuals, so they may secure good jobs in stable, high-demand occupations. DOL

requires applicants to propose strategies to achieve economic opportunity and address historical inequities.
