Subject: Funding Opportunity - Strengthening Community Colleges Training Grants Program

Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and other

local workforce partners of a funding opportunity through the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL), Employment and Training Administration (ETA), announcing the availability of approximately \$45,000,000 in grant funds authorized by the Section 169(c) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act for the second round of the Strengthening

Community Colleges (SCC2) Training Grants program.

Background: This second round of Strengthening Community Colleges Training Grants will increase

the capacity and responsiveness of community colleges to close equity gaps in addressing skill development needs of employers and workers, in support of the Biden-

Harris Administration's priorities to leverage and advance community colleges. Awarded grants will focus on accelerated learning strategies that support skill development, rapid reskilling, and employment through targeted industry sectors and career pathway approaches. These strategies will also address identified equity gaps to

increase full access to educational and economic opportunity – particularly for individuals from historically underrepresented and marginalized populations and

communities.

Funding Opportunity Number: FOA-ETA-22-02 **Application Deadline:** June 2, 2022 **Estimated Total Funding:** \$45,000,000

Award Ceiling: Single institution applicants may apply for a ceiling

amount of \$1.6 million and consortium lead applicants may apply for a ceiling amount of \$5

million.

Estimated Awards Granted: 5-7 consortia and 6-8 single institution grants.

Period of Performance: 48 Months beginning 9/1/22
