**Purpose:** To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators, and

other workforce partners that the Request for Proposal for the FY23 Massachusetts Skills Capital Grant Program Round 2 Technology and Equipment applica-

tion is posted on CommBuys.

**Background:** The Skills Capital Grant Program will award grants for the purchase and installa-

tion of equipment and related improvements and limited renovations necessary for installation and use of such equipment to support vocational and technical

training.

This equipment will upgrade and expand career technical education and training programs that are aligned to regional economic and workforce development priorities for in-demand industries, provided that grant applications facilitate collaboration to provide students training pathways to career opportunities in high-

skill, high-demand industry sectors. Please note that the list of priority occupations has been updated to include LPN and RN. The application includes a single year and multi-year request options. Preference maybe given to organizations that have not received Skills Capital Grant funding in FY23 or in the recent past. An informational webinar on September 22<sup>nd</sup> is being provided as noted below.
