The Workforce Skills Cabinet and Commonwealth Corporation have launched CTI to supply Vocational Technical Schools with the funding to expand new "after dark" training capacity that will **upskill new workers to address employers' hiring needs**

This program **pairs employers with local Vocational Technical Schools** that are training new workers with the skills necessary to fill in-demand occupations. The ultimate goal of these partnerships will be to create **sustainable talent development pipelines**.

As part of these partnerships, employers will be encouraged to provide **feedback on curriculum and screening methodologies**.

In addition to program funding, partnerships will receive **technical assistance and recruiting support** from MassHire Career Centers and regional workforce boards.
