Background: The Department is seeking to competitively procure Career, Technical and

Workforce Training and Employment Services for youth up to 22 years of age from entities that include educational institutions, workforce development agencies, community-based service providers and businesses with demonstrated track records of providing quality career, technical and workforce programs and

services. The goal is to give juvenile justice involved young people transferable work skills and realistic pathways to meaningful employment in the community.
