Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and

other local workforce partners that MassHire Department of Career Services is seeking ideas regarding the <u>Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) FY24 Second Chance Act Improving Reentry Education and Employment Outcomes</u> funding

opportunity.

Background: With this solicitation, the Bureau of Justice Assistance seeks to fund reentry

services and programs focused on strengthening education and employment outcomes for individuals returning to their communities after a period of

incarceration.

Please note, there are two funding categories for this solicitation:

Category 1: Improving Reentry Education Outcomes
Category 2: Improving Reentry Employment Outcomes

An applicant may submit more than one application if each application proposes a different project in response to the solicitation.

The purpose of this program is to support fair chance opportunities to improve education and employment outcomes for individuals currently incarcerated with 2 years or less before release into the community. For this solicitation, fair chance opportunities refer to reentry services and programs designed to increase access to in-demand jobs and meaningful careers for justice-impacted people upon and following their release from incarceration. Program contents may be education or employment focused.
