Subject: Applications Now Open - Behavioral Health Workforce Scholarship Program

Purpose: To notify MassHire Workforce Boards, MassHire Career Center Operators and

other local workforce partners that the Executive Office of Health and Human Services has opened the second round of applications for the graduate-level

Behavioral Health Workforce Scholarship program.

Background: The behavioral health workforce scholarships are funded by the Behavioral

Health Trust and provide direct financial support to graduate-level students

pursuing careers in behavioral health fields.

The application period is now open through January 20, 2026 at Office of Student Financial Assistance / Massachusetts Department of Higher Education.

Scholarships are available to actively enrolled full-time and part-time students pursuing master's degrees and graduate level certificates in a range of behavioral

health programs including social work, mental health counseling, substance use counseling, and mental health nursing programs.

Awards are up to \$12,500 for eligible students for the 2025-2026 academic year. Students who received funding last year must re-apply and may be eligible for a second year of funding, up to \$25,000 per student.
