through the Department of Economic Research (DER).

Background: The Department of Economic Research (formerly the Labor Market Information

(LMI) Division) produces, analyzes, and distributes various data, labor market

reports, and other resources related to employment, unemployment,

occupations, industries, and other components of the Massachusetts labor

market.

This Issuance replaces Information Issuance #100 DCS 30.100.

 Development provide a list of in-demand occupations that require an
 industry-recognized credential to the Department of Elementary and
 Secondary Education and make the list publicly available.
